Black Rock Mining Limited (ASX: BKT) – Request for trading halt

Black Rock Mining Limited (**Company**) requests an immediate trading halt be granted by ASX in respect of its ordinary shares. In accordance with ASX Listing Rule 17.1, the Company provides the following information:

- 1. **Reason for trading halt** the Company requests a trading halt effective immediately, pending the release of an announcement regarding a strategic investment in the Company.
